INTRODUCTION

The spate of insecurity in Nigeria continues unabatedly during the reviewing month, with the experience of wanton destruction of lives and property spread across board. The ceaseless onslaught on security agencies in the South-East and South-South regions is unprecedented and has assumed a worrisome dimension even as the number of casualties on the part of security agencies is on the increase on regular basis. Several Police stations were burnt down, while invaders succeeded in carting away arms and ammunitions, thereby strengthening their attacking capacity. Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) offices across the South East region have become the targets of the suspected separatists, ostensibly to frustrate the conduct of any election in the region as a precursor to achieving their age-long dream of Biafra nation.

Similarly, the Yoruba nation agitators in the South-West are equally waxing stronger on daily basis against the backdrop of unequivocal endorsement and support they are getting from notable individuals in the region. Their rallies are evident of support they garnered even as they are usually characterized by violence of attacks on security agencies especially at the border areas.

Kaduna was epic center for bandit invasion, wreaking havoc with killings of armless civilians. Series of kidnapping cases and rustling of cattle also pervades the Northern Nigeria in the month under review. Activities of Bokoharam are still as active as ever despite the ousting of Shekau faction from their strongholds in Sambisa. The dominance of ISWAP and possible adoption of more troops from Shekau's camp simply means the challenges on security forces are far from ending. Nevertheless, the remnants of Shekau's faction could also resort to guerilla attacks on ISWAP, while they will not relent in attacking military base for possible acquisition of arms and ammunition even as they have obviously been degraded.

The targeted killings of eminent Nigerians by unknown gunmen is an indicator of a failed system threatening the unity and existence of the nation. The narrative becomes more worrisome as a result of the obvious overwhelmed security agencies especially the Police. Responses to distress calls were very poor which also underscore the ineffective and obsolete Police equipment. Police personnel are seen to be naïve and weak with dampened moral, hence, the possibility of a new tactical and strategic approach in the coming month is not in view.

Finally, it is not out of place that the Federal Government should start appraising and re-appraising all identified and obvious areas of discontent with a view to dousing tension in the interest of peace and tranquility in the country.







North-Central

Plateau. April 29, 2021, gunmen in the early hours invaded Capro Secondary Mission School at Gana Ropp area, near Yakubu Gowon Airport in Barkin Ladi Local Government Area (LGA) and reportedly kidnapped four students. Following the incident, security forces tailed and recued three students.

Benue. April 26, 2021, gunmen suspected to be herdsmen invaded an Internal Displaced Persons (IDP) camp at Abagena community in Makurdi LGA, shooting sporadically and killing seven persons. On April 27, 2021, aggrieved residents mounted a roadblock along Makurdi-Lafia road in the community to protest over the killings.

Benue. April 27, 2021, two farmers were reportedly macheted to death as suspected herdsmen attacked them on a farmland at Tsewua community along Udei road in Guma LGA.

Benue. April 28, 2021, policemen raided suspected criminals' hideout at Tomatar forest area in Katsina-Ala LGA, killing three suspects and others escaped. Two AK47 riffles and 29 rounds of 7.62mm ammunition were recovered from the suspects.

Benue. April 29, 2021, nine persons were killed, and three others were injured as suspected herdsmen attacked Ahume and Tse-Nyarei communities in Gwer-West LGA.

Nasarawa. April 27, 2021, at 1815 hours, armed kidnappers fired gunshots at a motorist near Ugya village in Toto LGA and reportedly kidnapped seven passengers.

Nasarawa. May 1, 2021, a local government councillor was reportedly kidnapped in transit by gunmen near Okpata community in Doma LGA.

Kogi. April 26, 2021, gunmen fired gunshots at the convoy of a lawmaker along Okenne-Lokoja road around Osara community in Adavi LGA, injuring three policemen.

Kwara. May 1, 2021, gunmen fired gunshots at a vehicle of the Kogi State Pension Board Commissioner at Eruku community, a border community between Kwara and Kogi States in Ekiti LGA, killing the Commissioner and kidnapped one person believed to be a local government councillor who was in the same vehicle with the Commissioner.

Abuja. April 26, 2021, at 2300 hours, unidentified gunmen attacked a Fulani settlement at Sabon-Gari village in Kwali LGA, killing one person.

Abuja. May 1, 2021, at 2300 hours, suspected rival criminal cultists clashed at Mpape village in Bwari LGA, killing two persons and vandalising properties.

Niger. April 29, 2021, at 1300 hours, security forces in conjunction with local vigilante members exchanged gunfire with suspected armed criminals in an attack at Sarkin Pawa town in Munya LGA. No casualty was reported.

Niger. April 29, 2021, at 2300 hours, the mother of a lawmaker was reportedly kidnapped by gunmen in her residence at Mago village in Agwara LGA.

Plateau. May 4, 2021, at 2000 hours, gunmen invaded a residence at Furaka community in Jos North Local Government Area (LGA) and reportedly kidnapped a woman.

Benue. May 3, 2021, thirteen persons were reportedly killed, seven others were injured, and several houses were burnt as suspected herdsmen attacked Tse-Amgbem community near Aondoana in Gwer West LGA.

Niger. May 5, 2021, at 1245 hours, suspected armed criminals shot sporadically in an attack at Kwaki community in Shiroro LGA, killing one person and stealing goods and other valuables.

Niger. May 5, 2021, gunmen attacked, firing gunshots at Shadadi community in Mariga LGA, killing eight persons and injuring four others. The attackers kidnapped unconfirmed number of people from the community.

Niger. May 5, 2021, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Yangalu community in Magama LGA, killing seven person and vandalising properties. The attackers stole foodstuffs and other valuables.

Kwara. May 8, 2021, at 1900 hours, suspected herdsmen attacked and injured three farmers on their farmland at Afoyin community near Erin-Ile in Oyun LGA.







Abuja. May 7, 2021, members of the Islamic Shiite group clashed with policemen during a procession along Herbert Macaulay way near Berger area in Abuja Municipal Area Council (AMAC), killing one policeman and vandalizing properties. Forty-nine members of the group were arrested in connection to the incident.

Abuja. May 9, 2021, at 1100 hours, one person was reportedly killed as commercial motorcyclists clashed with policemen at Karu area, along Nyanya-Karshi road in AMAC.

Benue. May 14, 2021, at 0145 hours, unidentified gunmen invaded the palace of a traditional ruler along Jooji Kyado street at Gboko town in Gboko Local Government Area (LGA), injuring three persons and vandalising properties.

Benue. May 15, 2021, suspected herdsmen attacked Yelwata community in Guma LGA, killing four persons and injuring several others.

Benue. May 16, 2021, at 1700 hours, six unidentified gunmen attacked, firing gunshots at the Benue State Internal Revenue Service (BIRS) office at Zaki-Biam town in Ukum LGA, killing one person and injuring one other.

Plateau. May 13, 2021, a student at the Plateau State University was reportedly kidnapped around the campus premises by gunmen at Bokkos town in Bokkos LGA.

Kwara. May 15, 2021, suspected rival criminal cultists clashed around Dada area at Okelele community in Ilorin East LGA, injuring two persons.

Abuja. May 10, 2021, at 0300 hours, a burglary attempt was reported at the residence of the Chief of Staff to the President around the Presidential Villa area in Abuja Municipal Area Council (AMAC).

Abuja. May 10, 2021, two persons were killed, and several others were injured as aggrieved youths in Orozo community clashed with tricycle operators around Arab junction along Nyanya-Karshi road at

Orozo in AMAC. The incident was triggered when a tricycle operator allegedly slapped and injured a traditional ruler in an argument.

Niger. May 14, 2021, some rival youth gangs clashed around Anguwan Daji and Limawa areas at Minna town in Chanchaga LGA, injuring approximately thirty persons.

Nasarawa. May 15, 2021, gunmen suspected to be herdsmen invaded Amudu village in Keana LGA, shooting sporadically and killing three persons. Several houses were also burnt by the attackers.

Plateau. May 17, 2021, at 0200 hours, gunmen invaded the residence of a female university lecturer around Haske quarters, along Lamingo road in Jos North Local Government Area (LGA) and reportedly kidnapped the female lecturer alongside her husband. The kidnaped victims were released by their abductors on May 18, 2021.

Plateau. May 19, 2021, at 2030 hours, gunmen reportedly kidnapped four persons along Gaya Layout near Chichim Quarters at Mangu town in Mangu LGA. Following the incident, policemen and vigilante members tailed the kidnappers and rescued two victims. Four suspects were arrested, and others escaped with two kidnapped victims.

Plateau. May 23, 2021, at 2000 hours, unidentified gunmen attacked Dong village in Jos South LGA, killing seven persons and vandalising properties.

Plateau. May 23, 2021, eight persons were killed, and one other was injured as unidentified gunmen attacked Kwi village in Riyom LGA.

Benue. May 21, 2021, at 2300 hours, unidentified gunmen attacked, firing gunshots at Tse-Ancha community in Makurdi LGA, killing eight persons including a traditional ruler and injuring five others.

Nasarawa. May 18, 2021, at 1700 hours, gunmen fired gunshots at motorists in Ugya village along Shafa Abakpa-Umaisha road in Toto LGA, killing one driver and kidnapped thirteen passengers.

Abuja. May 17, 2021, aggrieved mob attacked and killed a motorcyclist over an accident at Kabusa area in Abuja Municipal Area Council (AMAC). Following the incident, on May 18, 2021, some residents clashed with policemen in a protest against motorcyclists' killings around Kabusa Police station, injuring one person.

Niger. May 17, 2021, at 1145 hours, gunmen exchanged gunfire with soldiers of the Nigerian Army stationed at a construction company at Libale village in Magama LGA, killing three soldiers and two suspects.





Niger. May 20, 2021, gunmen invaded the farmland of a traditional ruler at Masuga village along Kontagora-Rijau road in Kontagora LGA, killing three persons, including the son of the traditional ruler. The attackers also rustled several cattle on the farm. Security forces later tailed and killed seven suspects while others escaped.

Niger. May 20, 2021, at 0010 hours, armed kidnappers invaded Kwankwashe community in Suleja LGA, killing three persons and kidnapped twelve others.


Niger. May 23, 2021, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Ibeto community in Magama LGA, stealing goods and other valuables. One person was also killed by the attackers.

Kwara. May 17, 2021, at 2100 hours, two persons were reportedly killed as some farmers clashed with Fulani herdsmen over grazing on a farmland at Pada village in Edu LGA.

Kwara. May 19, 2021, armed kidnappers invaded a residence at Adeta area in Ilorin town, Ilorin West LGA and reportedly kidnapped one person.


Niger. On May 24, 2021, at 0300 hours, gunmen attacked residents of Angwan-Wazobia area at Gauraka community in Suleja LGA and kidnapped six persons. Following the incident, aggrieved residents mounted a roadblock and burnt a police station in the community along Abuja-Kaduna road.


Kogi. On May 25, 2021, at 0015 hours, suspected armed criminals clashed with local vigilante members as they attempted to attack Gegu-Beki community in Koton-Karfe LGA. No casualty was reported.















South-West

Oyo. April 30, 2021, at 0900 hours, gunmen suspected to be herdsmen shot and killed one person on a farmland at Idere community in Ibarapa Central LGA.

Ogun. April 27, 2021, at 0300 hours, unidentified gunmen invaded the residence of a businessman along Tella Ojo crescent at Atan-Ota town in Ado-Odo/Ota LGA, killing the businessman and his wife.

Ogun. May 1, 2021, two persons were reportedly kidnapped on their farmland by gunmen at Omu community near Ofada town in Obafemi/Owode LGA.

Lagos. April 26, 2021, two persons were reportedly killed, and several others were injured as some commercial motorcycle operators clashed with members of the National Union of Road Transport Workers over tax levied on the motorcyclists around Iyana Iba and Alaba Rago areas, along Lagos-Badagry expressway in Ojo LGA.

Lagos. April 26, 2021, at 1030 hours, some commercial motorcyclists attacked policemen with stones and bottles in a police raid along Hakeem Dickson Link road at Lekki Phase 1 area, Eti-Osa LGA. The policemen fired gunshots into the air to disperse them. Several motorcyclists were arrested, and their motorcycles were seized.

Lagos. April 29, 2021, at 1945 hours, suspected armed criminals attacked and robbed motorists in traffic at Eko Bridge area in Lagos Island LGA.

Oyo. May 3, 2021, suspected herdsmen attacked a farmer with machete on his farmland at Tapa community in Ibarapa North LGA, killing the farmer.

Osun. May 7, 2021, four persons were reportedly killed as residents from Ile Ogbo and Iwo communities in Aiyedire and Iwo LGAs clashed over land tussle at a border area in Oke-Saji area, along Iwo-Ile-Oogbo road near Ile Ogbo community.

Ondo. May 3, 2021, some rival youth gangs clashed over leadership tussle at Ikare Akoko community in Akoko North-East LGA, killing two persons and vandalising properties.

Ondo. May 5, 2021, suspected armed criminal cultists in the early hours clashed with members of the Oodua People's Congress (OPC) around Idasen and Ijebu areas at Owo town in Owo LGA, killing two persons and burning two houses in the fracas.

Ondo. May 6, 2021, at 1730 hours, armed robbers attacked, firing gunshots at a bullion van at Elemoso community along Akure-Ondo expressway in Ondo East LGA, reportedly killing two persons, injuring one other, and stealing undisclosed amount of money.

Ogun. May 4, 2021, at 2000 hours, gunmen intercepted a vehicle along Ayetoro-Ilara road around Olubo community in Abeokuta North LGA and reportedly kidnapped four passengers.

Ogun. May 5, 2021, gunmen ambushed a convoy of the state government officials at Ibara Orile community in Abeokuta North LGA, killing one police escort and kidnapped four persons.

Ogun. May 6, 2021, at 0200 hours, gunmen suspected to be smugglers exchanged gunfire with security forces at Oja-Odan community in Yewa North LGA, killing two suspects and arrested one other. Five security operatives and five civilians were also injured in the crossfire.

Lagos. May 5, 2021, at 0630 hours, suspected rival criminal thugs clashed around Adeniji bus stop off Third Mainland Bridge in Lagos Island LGA. No casualty was reported.

Lagos. May 6, 2021, armed suspected rival criminal cultists clashed at Gengere, Mile 12 area along Ikorodu road in Kosofe LGA, killing one person, injuring several others and vandalising properties. Motorists and pedestrians were also robbed in the fracas.

Lagos. May 7, 2021, at 0930 hours, one person was killed as commercial motorcyclists clashed with policemen at Ogba area in Ifako-Ijaiye LGA.

Ogun. May 10, 2021, at 2000 hours, two armed robbers attacked a motorcyclist around Joju area at Sango Ota town in Ado-Odo/Ota LGA, injuring the motorcyclist and stealing his motorcycle.







Ogun. May 15, 2021, armed robbers in the early hours invaded a warehouse around Ipamesan area at Sango Ota town in Ado-Odo/Ota LGA, killing a security guard and stealing valuables. Following the incident, policemen tailed and arrested one suspect after exchanging gunfire with the suspects. The police recovered one long gun, 41 laptops, 2DVD players, five phones, and two vehicles from the suspects.

Ondo. May 10, 2021, gunmen invaded a church premises at Irese community in Akure North LGA and reportedly kidnapped a clergyman. The kidnapped clergyman was released by his abductors on May 15, 2021.

Ondo. May 15, 2021, at 1900 hours, four armed robbers riding on two motorcycles attacked a filling station along Oda road in Akure town, killing one person and stealing undisclosed amount of money.

Oyo. May 10, 2021, at 1800 hours, armed men suspected to be herdsmen intercepted a motorcycle along Igangan-Iganna road near Iwere-Ile village in Iwajowa LGA, killing one person.

Oyo. May 13, 2021, at 1600 hours, five persons were killed as suspected smugglers clashed with officials of the Nigeria Customs Service around Barracks area along Iseyin-Ibadan expressway at Iseyin town in Iseyin LGA.

Osun. May 11, 2021, gunmen suspected to be herdsmen attacked and killed two farmers on their farmland around Alapata area at Modakeke town in Ife East LGA.

Osun. May 13, 2021, unidentified gunmen invaded a residence around Arulogun area at Ede town in Ede South LGA, shooting sporadically and killing two persons. Following the incident, policeman tailed and arrested five suspects in connection to the incident. One single barrel gun, one Dane gun, eight expended cartridges, axes, cutlasses, charms and five motorcycles were recovered from the suspects.

Lagos. May 10, 2021, at 0700 hours, suspected criminals attacked and robbed motorists in a traffic congestion at Eko Bridge, inwards Lagos Island in Lagos Island LGA.

Oyo. May 23, 2021, two persons were reportedly killed in a clashed between suspected smugglers and officers of the Nigerian Customs Service at Eruwa town, Ibarapa East LGA.

Oyo. May 23, 2021, at 2200 hours, gunmen invaded a residence at Aromolaran area along Old Ife road in Ibadan North LGA and reportedly kidnapped a woman.

Osun. May 18, 2021, at 0630 hours, aggrieved youths mounted a roadblock with bonfires at Lameco Junction and Dele Yes Sir roundabout at Osogbo town in Osogbo LGA to protest against the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) raid at Hallelujah and Adetunji Estates in the early hours of the same day.

Osun. May 22, 2021, at 1430 hours, suspected rival criminal cultists clashed, firing gunshots along Asoje street in Osogbo town, killing one person.

Osun. May 22, 2021, at 1800 hours, armed robbers attacked and robbed motorists of their belongings around Iwaraja, along Akure-Ilesha road in Oriade LGA. Policemen in conjunction with local vigilante members later repelled the attack and exchanged gunfire with the suspects.

Ekiti. May 20, 2021, suspected rival criminal cultists in the early hours clashed at Ikere Ekiti town in Ikere LGA, killing two persons.

Ogun. May 20, 2021, at 1900 hours, gunmen double crossed a lecturer while driving along GRA road in Ijebu Ode town in Ijebu Ode LGA and reportedly kidnapped the lecturer.

Ogun. May 22, 2021, at 0800 hours, gunmen attacked and kidnapped three farmers on their farmland at Abule Itoko village in Odeda LGA.

Lagos. May 18, 2021, at 2000 hours, suspected armed criminals in a private vehicle robbed some unsuspecting passengers of their money and valuables as they boarded the private vehicle running commercial service at Admiralty way, Lekki in Eti-Osa LGA. The victims were picked in batches and their debits cards and financial details were collected while driven around to make withdrawals from ATMs.

Lagos. May 19, 2021, at 1600 hours, suspected rival criminal cultists clashed, firing gunshots at Gberigbe area, Ikorodu LGA, killing one person and injuring five others.








Lagos. May 19, 2021, at 1100 hours, five persons were killed, and five others were injured as factions of the All-Progressives Congress party members clashed, firing gunshots at Oko-Baba area near Ebute Metta in Lagos Mainland LGA.

Lagos. May 20, 2021, at 0745 hours, troops of the Nigerian Airforce raided suspected criminals' hideout at Oshodi area in Oshodi-Isolo LGA, following the alleged killing of an Airforce officer by some criminals at Mosafejo in Oshodi. **Lagos.** On May 24, 2021, at 1400 hours, one person was killed as some commercial motorcyclists clashed with policemen around Ile-Epo bus stop at Oke-Odo area, along Lagos-Abeokuta expressway in Alimosho LGA.






















North-West

Kaduna. April 30, 2021, at 2100 hours, suspected armed criminals attacked Kaso community In Chikun LGA, reportedly rustling cattle and stealing other valuables.

Kaduna. May 1, 2021, at 0010 hours, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots around Ungwan Auta area at Gonin Gora community in Chikun LGA and reportedly kidnapped four persons. Following the incident, aggrieved residents mounted a roadblock with bonfires along Abuja-Kaduna expressway to protest the kidnapping.

Katsina. April 26, 2021, at 0040 hours, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Sayau kasuwa, Unguwa Nakaba and Sayau Malamai communities in Sabuwa LGA, killing six persons and stealing valuables.

Katsina. April 30, 2021, suspected armed criminals in the early hours attacked, firing gunshots at Dangani village in Musawa LGA, killing one person and kidnapped four others.

Katsina. April 30, 2021, gunmen invaded the residence of a lecturer at Dutsin-Ma town, Dutsin-Ma LGA and reportedly kidnapped three children.

Jigawa. April 27, 2021, at 0130 hours, one person was reportedly kidnapped in an attack by gunmen at Aguza village in Auyo LGA.

Sokoto. April 27, 2021, at 0550 hours, suspected armed criminals invaded a residence at Kainuwa village in Kware LGA, stealing money and other valuables. Some residents tailed and apprehended two suspects that were later handed over to the police at Kware town. Following the incident, aggrieved youths demanding the release of the two suspects attacked a police station at Kware town in Kware LGA, killing one suspect and injuring one other. The attackers also burnt the station and three vehicles.

Zamfara. April 26, 2021, at 1430 hours, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Kukaburtu and Dankurmi communities in Maru LGA, killing ten persons and reportedly kidnapped unconfirmed number of others. The attackers stole goods and other valuables.

Zamfara. May 1, 2021, security forces exchanged gunfire with suspected armed criminals at Kuraje community in Gusau LGA, killing several suspects and recovered 300 rustled cattle from the suspects.

Kano. May 5, 2021, suspected armed kidnappers shot sporadically as they invaded a residence around Ungwar Yamadawa at Dorayi Baba quarters in Gwale LGA. Following the incident, some aggrieved residents and vigilante members chased and arrested two suspects. A stolen tricycle machine was also recovered from the suspects.

Kaduna. May 4, 2021, suspected armed criminals shot sporadically in an attack at Mazari community near Buruku town in Chikun LGA, killing one person and injuring three others.

Kaduna. May 4, 2021, one person was killed, and three others were injured as suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Doka village in Kajuru LGA.

Kaduna. May 5, 2021, gunmen attacked, firing gunshots at Gwagwada and Lukuru communities in Chikun LGA, killing two persons and kidnapping thirteen others. All the kidnapped victims were reportedly rescued after exchanging gunfire with the suspects.

Kaduna. May 6, 2021, at 0800 hours, a commercial motorcyclist was reportedly abducted by unknown gunmen at Mabuhu village in Zangon Kataf LGA.

Kaduna. May 7, 2021, suspected armed criminals in the early hours invaded a Fulani settlement at Kukumake village in Igabi LGA and reportedly kidnapped three persons and rustled several cattle. Following the incident security forces intercepted and exchanged gunfire with the criminals around Rigachikun area along Kaduna-Zaria expressway in Igabi LGA, killing one suspect and recued all the kidnapped victims. The rustled cattle were also recovered from the suspects.

Kaduna. May 8, 2021, gunmen invaded the residence of a community leader at Golkofa, Jema'a LGA, killing the community leader, two family members and injuring one person.

Katsina. May 4, 2021, at 0700 hours, suspected armed criminals ambushed a police patrol team at Ruma village in Batsari LGA, reportedly killing one policeman and injuring one other.







Katsina. May 8, 2021, suspected armed criminals in the early hours attacked, firing gunshots at Tsaskiya community in Safana LGA, killing eleven persons and injuring three others. The attackers stole goods and other valuables.

Sokoto. May 5, 2021, some local vigilante members repelled suspected criminals as they attack Ruga community in Goronyo LGA, killing three suspects.

Zamfara. May 5, 2021, suspected armed criminals in the early hours attacked, firing gunshots at Kayaye community in Shinkafi LGA, stealing foodstuffs and other valuables.

Kaduna. May 11, 2021, suspected armed criminals exchanged gunfire with some local vigilante members in an attack at Rafin Tukurwa village in Birnin Gwari LGA, killing one vigilante member. The attackers rustled cattle and stole other valuables.

Kaduna. May 13, 2021, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Baburum village in Giwa LGA, stealing goods and other valuables.

Kaduna. May 13, 2021, suspected armed criminals shot sporadically in an attack at Rafin Malmo village in Kauru LGA, killing three persons and injuring several others.

Kaduna. May 14, 2021, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Rafin Tukurwa and Takama villages of Birnin Gwari LGA, killing five persons and stealing valuables.

Kaduna. May 14, 2021, armed cattle rustlers invaded Rugar Alhaji Ja'eh village in Igabi LGA, killing two persons and rustled approximately two hundred cattle.

Kaduna. May 16, 2021, suspected armed criminals attacked a joint security forces camp in Kakau area in Chikun LGA and the security operatives repelled the attack, killing six suspects.

Katsina. May 10, 2021, at 0200 hours, gunmen invaded a mosque during a prayer in Yakin Kwata area at the outskirt of Jibiya town in Jibiya LGA, shooting sporadically and reportedly kidnapped approximately forty worshippers inside the mosque. Following the incident, security forces tailed the suspects and reportedly rescued thirty victims.

Katsina. May 10, 2021, at 1100 hours, policemen raided suspected criminal's hideout near Kankara town in Kankara LGA and arrested four suspects. The police recovered one hundred and seventy cows and thirty-eight sheep from the suspects.

Sokoto. May 11, 2021, at 0145 hours, suspected armed criminals exchanged gunfire with policemen at Rumjin Sambo community in Sokoto South LGA, killing one policeman.

Zamfara. May 11, 2021, suspected armed criminals in the early hours attacked, firing gunshots at Samawa village in Bungudu LGA, stealing foodstuffs and other valuables.

Zamfara. May 15, 2021, at 1600 hours, suspected armed criminals invaded Kwanar-Maje village in Anka LGA and reportedly rustled several cattle.

Following the incident, soldiers of the Nigerian Navy tailed and killed three suspects while two others were arrested near Kaso village in Chikun LGA. All the rustled cattle were also recovered.

Kaduna. May 19, 2021, armed cattle rustlers invaded a Fulani settlement at Marraban Jos village in Igabi LGA, killing three persons and rustled several cattle.

Kaduna. May 19, 2021, at 2000 hours, gunmen exchanged gunfire with policemen as they attempted to attack a police station at Godogodo village in Jema'a LGA, killing one person in the shootout.







Kaduna. May 19, 2021, gunmen in the early hours attacked Ungwan Gaida community, near Kurmin Kaso town in Chikun LGA, killing eight persons and several houses were burnt, including a church. The attackers stole foodstuffs and other valuables.

Kaduna. May 20, 2021, at 2315 hours suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Zangon Aya community in Igabi LGA, killing two persons and kidnapped two others. In a similar incident, gunmen invaded a Fulani settlement at Rugar Delu community in Igabi LGA, injuring one person and rustled approximately thirty cows.

Kaduna. May 20, 2021, gunmen invaded Ungwan Murtala area at Yakawada village in Giwa LGA, killing one person and injuring three others.

Kaduna. May 22, 2021, at 1500 hours, suspected armed criminals shot and killed a driver of the Emir of Birnin Gwari in transit along Buruku-Birnin Gwari road at Unguwan Yako forest in Birnin Gwari LGA.

Kaduna. May 23, 2021, at 0130 hours, gunmen invaded Unguwan Kabulo community in Chikun LGA, shooting sporadically and kidnapped fourteen persons.

Katsina. May 18, 2021, at 2200 hours, gunmen shot sporadically in an attack at Batsari town in Batsari LGA, killing one person and kidnapping twenty-one others.

Katsina. May 18, 2021, at 1500 hours, a Sharia Court judge was reportedly kidnapped at the court premises by gunmen at Baure Zaka village in Safana LGA.

Katsina. May 20, 2021, at 2300 hours, gunmen shot sporadically in an attack at a church premises at Malunfashi town in Malunfashi LGA, killing one clergyman and kidnapped one other.

Katsina. May 21, 2021, suspected armed criminals attacked Yantuwaru village in Faskari LGA, stealing valuables and burning several houses.

Sokoto. May 21, 2021, at 2230 hours, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Garin Zogo village in Sabon Birni LGA, killing three persons and injuring one other. The attackers rustled cattle and stole goods from the residents.

Sokoto. May 22, 2021, armed cattle rustlers invaded Nasarawa, Gidan Idi and Rambadawa villages in Sabon Birni LGA, injuring three persons and rustled several cattle.

Zamfara. May 18, 2021, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at Dansadau town in Maru LGA, stealing goods and rustling cattle.

Zamfara. May 18, 2021, suspected armed criminals attacked motorists along Dansadau – Gusau road in Maru LGA and reportedly kidnapped eighteen travellers.

Zamfara. May 22, 2021, at 0900 hours, suspected armed criminals attacked, firing gunshots at farmers on their farmland at Damaga village in Maradun LGA, killing eight farmers and injuring five others.

Zamfara. On May 24, 2021, at 2300 hours, suspected armed criminals clashed with policemen and local vigilante members in an attack at Hayin Daudu village in Gusau LGA, killing ten suspects and others escaped.

Sokoto. On May 24, 2021, suspected armed criminals clashed with local vigilante members at Gandi town in Rabah LGA, killing twenty-one persons and rustled several cattle.

Sokoto. On May 24, 2021, at 0800 hours gunmen attacked some traders who were travelling along Shinkafi-Sabon Birni road in Sabon Birni LGA, killing one person and stealing undisclosed amount of money from them.





Borno. May 2, 2021, at 1000 hours, suspected Boko Haram militants in several gun trucks and motorcycles attacked a military base at Ajiri village in Mafa LGA, reportedly killing one soldier and three civilians. The attackers burnt nine houses and stole arms, ammunition and three vehicles.

Taraba. May 1, 2021, suspected armed criminals reportedly kidnapped fifteen farmers as they attack their farmlands at Suntai community in Bali LGA. The kidnapped victims were later rescued by local vigilante members.

Yobe. April 29, 2021, at 1800 hours, suspected Boko Haram militants in two groups simultaneously attacked, shooting sporadically at kanamma town in Yunusari LGA and a military base in the town, killing four soldiers, three policemen and injuring three soldiers. Forty-six soldiers and policemen were reportedly missing after the crossfire. The attackers burnt the military base, one telecommunication mast, two NGOs vehicles, two vehicles' belongings to the traditional ruler and some military equipment while three-gun trucks, one RPG 7 tube and seven AK47 rifles were stolen by the militants.

Adamawa. May 4, 2021, at 0100 hours, gunmen invaded the residence of a journalist around Mbamba area at Yola in Yola South LGA and reportedly kidnapped the journalist.

Borno. May 7, 2021, troops of the Nigerian Army exchanged gunfire with suspected Boko Haram militants at Dille village in Askira Uba LGA, killing several militants.

Borno. May 11, 2021, at 1800 hours, troops of the Nigerian Army in conjunction with policemen and local vigilante members exchanged gunfire with suspected Boko Haram militants in Jiddari Polo area at the outskirts of Maiduguri, killing nine militants and others escaped. One Buffalo Gun Truck, three

motorcycles, three Machine Guns, a Rocket Propelled Gun, one Improvised Explosive Device, sixteen 12V batteries and four AK 47 rifles were recovered from the militants.

Borno. May 10, 2021, suspected Boko Haram militants exchanged gunfire with troops of the Nigerian Army at a military base at Ngwom town in Mafa LGA, injuring unconfirmed number of soldiers.

Borno. May 12, 2021, at 1200 hours, troops of the Nigerian Army exchanged gunfire with suspected Boko Haram militants around Mammanti area at Molai town in Konduga LGA, killing unconfirmed number of militants.

Borno. May 15, 2021, troops of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed forty suspected Boko Haram militants in a raid at their hideout at Dawuri village in Konduga LGA.

Borno. May 16, 2021, at 2000 hours, suspected Boko Haram militants exchanged gunfire with troops of the Nigerian Army in an attack at a military base at Dikwa town in Dikwa LGA. No further details were reported.

Taraba. May 13, 2021, at 1300 hours, suspected herdsmen attacked farmers at Jatau Kungana and Gazabu villages in Bali LGA, killing six persons and injuring several others.

Taraba. May 16, 2021, ten persons were reportedly killed as suspected herdsmen attacked, firing gunshots at Bornon Kurkur village in Bali LGA.

Taraba. May 23, 2021, five persons were reportedly macheted to death by suspected herdsmen in an attack at Ukoo Abaa village in Takum LGA. The attackers also robbed residents of their belongings.



Akwa Ibom. April 27, 2021, at 1900 hours, unidentified gunmen ridding on two motorcycles attacked a police checkpoint at Urua Inyang community in Ika LGA, shooting sporadically and killing two policemen. One patrol vehicle was burnt by the attackers.

Edo. April 29, 2021, gunmen reportedly kidnapped a man on his way to farm around Egoro area at Ekpoma in Esan West LGA.

Delta. April 27, 2021, gunmen suspected to be criminal cultists shot and killed one person around Shawarma area, off Genesis road in Oghara town, Ethiope West LGA.

Delta. April 30, 2021, four persons were reportedly killed as youths from Ekigbo and Otoiwereko communities clashed over land tussle around Ughelli Market area in Ughelli North LGA.

Their rifles were also stolen by the attackers.

May 7, 2021, gunmen exchanged gunfire with policemen in an attack at a police station in Elimgbu area in Obio-Akpor LGA, killing three policemen, injuring one other, and stealing four AK47 rifles. The attackers escaped with wounds on a stolen vehicle and the stolen vehicle was later abandoned around Refinery junction area.

Bayelsa. May 3, 2021, suspected rival criminal cultists clashed around Swali Market area in Yenagoa, killing two persons and injuring two others.

Akwa Ibom. May 8, 2021, at 0245 hours, unidentified gunmen attacked, firing gunshots at a police station at Odoro Ikpe community in Ini LGA, reportedly killing five policemen, and one civilian. The attackers vandalised the station and burnt some vehicles inside the station.





Abia. May 9, 2021, at 0945 hours, gunmen in four vehicles and two motorcycles exchanged gunfire with policemen at their station along Umuahia-Uzoakoli road, near Ubani market at Umuahia in Umuahia North LGA injuring one policeman and vandalising properties.

Enugu. May 11, 2021, suspected armed criminals reportedly hijacked a vehicle from where it was parked along Abakaliki road in Enugu city.

May 16, 2021, at 2200 hours, unidentified gunmen attacked the office of the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) around Agric Bank Bus stop along Independence Layout in Enugu and reportedly burnt six vehicles and vandalised two others. May 21, 2021, at 1230 hours, armed robbers reportedly tailed a Chinese expatriate from a commercial bank to Mission Hill area in Umuahia, shooting sporadically and killing his driver and a policeman escorting the expatriate. The attackers reportedly stole an undisclosed amount of money, while the Chinese expatriate escaped.

Anambra. May 20, 2021, at 1045 hours, three armed robbers attacked and robbed pedestrians of their belongings around Nkpor junction at Nkpor town in Idemili North LGA. The robbers were later apprehended and burnt to death by aggrieved mob in the area.

Anambra. May 21, 2021, gunmen attacked and exchanged gunfire with operatives of the Nigerian Security and Civil Defence Corps at Nneyi Umueri town in Anambra East LGA, killing two officers, burning their operational vehicle, and stealing two rifles.

Anambra. May 23, 2021, at 2000 hours, unidentified gunmen in three black Hilux vans attacked a police station at High Court road in Awka and the office of the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) in Awka and policemen repelled the attack, reportedly killing four suspects and others escaped. The attackers burnt part of the station, INEC office and seven vehicles in the attack.

Ebonyi. May 18, 2021, three INEC offices were burnt by unidentified attackers at Izzi, Ebonyi, and Ezza North LGAs.

Ebonyi. May 22, 2021, at 1200 hours, twenty gunmen attacked a police station at Ugbuodo community in Ebonyi LGA and exchanged gunfire with policemen, killing one suspect and a policeman while two other suspects were arrested. The police recovered one Ak 47 rifle, Jack knife and a bus from the gunmen.







Imo. May 18, 2021, at 2100 hours, suspected rival criminal cultists clashed, shooting sporadically at Douglas, Tetlow, Wethdral and Mbaise road in Owerri city, reportedly killing one person.

Imo. May 19, 2021, at 0745 hours, unidentified gunmen dressed in military uniform shot and killed a policeman who was on mufti at Ukwu Uratta road in Owerri, Owerri North LGA.


Enugu. May 23, 2021, at 2300 hours, unidentified gunmen attacked and burnt the INEC office at Ibagwa town in Igboeze South LGA.

Enugu. On May 25, 2021, unidentified gunmen in the early hours attacked a police station at Iwollo Oghe community in Ezeagu LGA, killing four policemen, burning the station and reportedly stole rifles.

Ebonyi. On May 25, 2021, at 1200 hours, a policeman accidentally detonated a grenade at a duty post near Eke Market at Afikpo town in Afikpo North LGA, killing the policeman.

Imo. On May 25, 2021, at 1305 hours, policemen exchanged gunfire with unidentified gunmen in an attack at a police station along Okigwe road at Orji community in Owerri North LGA and arrested five suspects. The police also recovered three vehicles from the suspects. No casualty was reported.

Imo. On May 24, 2021, at 1820 hours, policemen raided suspected criminal's hideout at Ocha community in Ohaji/Egbema LGA, killing two suspects and others escaped. One Ak47 rifle and a cache of live ammunition were recovered from the suspects.
